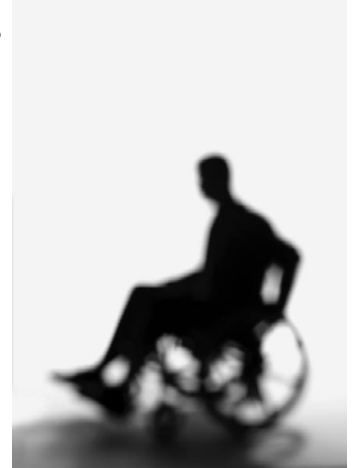

Complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Makes Sense

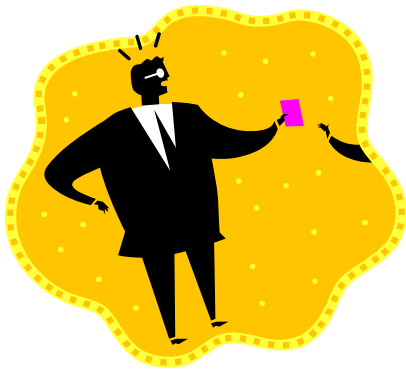
