Reduce Your Chances of a Lawsuit

Get inspected & get into compliance.

Business owners in California that would like to reduce, if not eliminate, the risk of an ADA/accessibility lawsuit at their location can hire a Certified Access Specialists (CASp Inspector). The CASp Inspector can help determine which accessibility standards apply to your particular location and develop a plan for compliance.

HR California recommends hiring a CASp Inspector through your attorney. Even though they are licensed by the state of California, they are not state employees and their rates vary considerably. Please visit the link below to view a current listing of Certified Access Specialists

Make sure you request a written report detailing what was inspected. Without one, business owners will not have proof of the inspection and may not be entitled to many of the benefits Disability Access Law Reform SB 1608 provides.
