



VOCATIONAL NURSING APPLICATION

The following are the prerequisites for the Tri-County ROP Vocational Nursing Program at Sutter County One Stop.

Prerequisites:

1. **Fill out an application for the vocational nursing program.** Once you have completed your application, please call Pam Mahmoudi, RN, MS, Director, Tri-County ROP Vocational Nursing Program, at 822-5120, ext. 3046. Leave a message stating your name, phone number, and a brief message that you would like to apply for the VN Program. Pam will call you back to schedule the first interview to discuss the prerequisites, answer any questions, etc. (A second interview with Pam and other nursing instructors will be scheduled two to three months before the VN class starts to choose who will be in the next VN class.) Bring as many of the items listed below that you have completed to the interview.
2. **Must have a current CNA Certificate from the Department of Health Services.** CNA classes are offered at Sutter County One Stop. For further information, ask Pam during the interview and/or check the internet website—www.sutteronestop.com for the next CNA classes. Call 822-5120, ext. 3049, leave a message with our instructional assistant about registering for CNA classes and your call will be returned.
3. **Must have a high school diploma or GED.** Please bring a copy of your diploma or GED for our records. You may submit an official transcript of any ROP, college, or other school classes that you would like to include with your application. We offer classes for a high school diploma and GED at Sutter County One Stop. Call 822-5120, ext. 3020 for further information.
4. **Take the Health Careers Math and English Assessment Test.** The assessment must be passed with post high school scores (PHS) in both Math and English. Remedial courses are available at Sutter County One Stop to bring up your scores to the PHS level. You may test again after completion of the remedial courses. Contact our instructional assistant at 822-5120, ext. 3027, to schedule this test. Leave a message with your name and phone number and your call will be returned.
5. **Must complete Anatomy and Physiology course.** This course can be taken at Sutter County One Stop. To find out more information, as to when this class will be starting, please call 822-5120, ext. 3049. Leave a message and your call will be returned. If you have already taken this course at another school within the last five years and a grade of "B" or better was obtained, with at least 54 hours spent in the course, this may satisfy the prerequisite. Please bring an official transcript. Medical

Assistants may possibly be granted credit for this course. Please check with Pam during your first interview.

6. **Must have a Negative TB Mantoux Test.** The test must be taken within one year of the start of the VN Program. If your previous test was positive, a chest x-ray needs to be done with a report showing no active disease. This will be done yearly while being a student in the VN Program.
7. **Must have a physical examination done stating you are physically able to do the VN Program.** This is to be performed by a physician stating that the individual is an able to perform the duties of a VN student. This should be done within one year of starting the VN Program.
8. **Must have completed the Hepatitis B vaccination series (3 injections) or be in the process of this and has received at least one injection by the beginning of the VN Program.** A Hepatitis B TITER showing immunity may be used instead.
9. **Must have a negative drug screen test.** This free test will be done on applicants that are chosen for the next VN Program within one month before/or after the class starts. If the test is positive, the student will be dropped from the program. This position will be filled by an alternate student who passed the drug test.
10. **Must complete Medical Terminology (at least 19 hours).** This course is offered at Sutter County One Stop as a separate course and also in the Medical Office Services class and the Health Care Information Services class. If this course was done at another school within the last five years for at least 19 hours and a grade of "B" or better, this may satisfy this requirement. Please bring your official transcript so that we may review this during your first interview. Medical Assistants may possibly be granted credit for this course, especially if the course was articulated with Yuba College, etc
11. **Have an active CPR card—Healthcare Provider from the American Heart Association or "Professional Rescuer" from the American Red Cross.** This needs to be renewed during the VN Program when the card expires.
12. **Complete a Basic First Aid Course.** This may be done at the American Red Cross—673-1460 or another provider of a First Aid Course, preferably done within the last 2-5 years. An EMT or Paramedic Certification can be used in place of this course.
13. **Proof of a MMR vaccination (measles, mumps, and rubella) booster or TITER to prove immunity.** This is a requirement to be able to do the Obstetrics and Pediatrics Module in the VN Program.
14. **Two letters of recommendations stating why you are a good candidate for the VN Program from professional business people, such as teachers, nurses, physicians, managers, etc.**
