

## **Job seekers down but is economy improving?**

About 400 people turned out for a job fair hosted by Sutter County One Stop today at the Veterans Memorial Hall in Yuba City.

The turnout at "Fall into a New Job" was about half of what it was at an employment fair just four months earlier, a indicator organizers see as a good sign.

"I would like to think that all those other people who were here last time are working," said Linda Baker, One-Stop business and workforce specialist.

But despite reports on the economy predicting a more positive outlook in the future, not all job seekers think the competition or the employment search is going to get any easier any time soon.

To say the economy is rebounding is a misuse of terms, said Randy Lauff, of Marysville.

"Maybe we should say we have hit bottom," he said. "I think its going to take a while before things improve."
