## Medical job fair Tuesday

More than 40 employers in the medical industry will be accepting applications for a variety of positions during the Medical Industry Job Fair in Yuba City on Tuesday.

Bobby Chima, a business and workforce specialist and the job fair coordinator, said the positions range from registered nurses to custodians.

"This is a great opportunity to inquire about job opening," she said. "We advise all attendees to come professionally dressed. Some employers will give interviews."

The event is free and runs from 10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at Veterans Hall, 1425 Veterans Memorial Circle, behind Yuba City City Hall.

The event is in its third year and is sponsored by the Career Training & Education Center/ Sutter County One Stop.

The job fair will be a great opportunity for students looking to go into the medical field to explore what kind of education they will need to get a job in the industry, Chima said. Prospective medical-industry students can also talk with the Regional Occupation Program, Cambridge Career College and the University of Phoenix about training programs.

Among the medical institutions seeking workers will be Fremont-Rideout Health Group, BloodSource, Enloe Medical Center, Shriner's Hospital in Sacramento, Sutter North Medical Foundation and many others, Chima said.

Chima emphasized that the fair is not only for medical professionals, but also for people who want to be receptionists, cooks, custodians, dietary aides and maintenance staff, among other positions.

Employment specialists will be on hand to help job seekers fill out applications free of charge, she said.

Last year, about 350 people attended the event, and this year Chima hopes 500 will attend.

"The employers last year thought it was great," she said. "They're all coming back."
